FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Meth cooks are getting the propane tanks from the exchanges at Wal-Mart, Kroger, gas stations, etc. and emptying them of the propane. They are filling them with anhydrous ammonia (which is used in meth recipe). After they are finished with them, they return them to the store. They are then filled with propane and sent back for you to buy.

Anhydrous Ammonia is very corrosive and weakens the structure of the tank. It can be extremely dangerous when mixed with propane and hooked up to our grills.
